### **Stationery for 2010 – Room 1 (Teacher: Cheryl Kidd)**

We ask that you purchase the following stationery for your child during the holidays so that every child will have their stationery available on the first day of term, 2<sup>nd</sup> February, 2010.

May we suggest you look carefully at **quality** as well as price, particularly good quality pencils. We will keep a small stock of stationery at school for children to purchase during the year as their exercise books run out.

- 8 Pencils – To be kept in desk
- 1 30cm ruler ( Not flexi and with cms and mms)
- 1 Eraser
- 2 Sharpie Black Permanent marker (Fine point)
- 1 Sharpener
- 1 Packet 12 full-size coloured pencils and felts
- 4 Large glue sticks (1 per term or as needed)
- 2 Good quality scrapbooks (not newsprint) - Topic & Maths
- 6 115 Exercise books (Handwriting, Draft, Homework, English, 2 spare)
- 1 SA4 Science Book (One page lined, one page blank) - for RE.
- 1 IH5 Maths book
- 1 20 page Clearfile to present published work (Old one can be re-used)
- 1 Art envelope – A3 size (Manilla) – Only if your child needs a new one
- 1 LARGE box of tissues and another box in Term 3
- 1 Journal bag (Large) If your child does not already have one – for library books and notices
- 1 Calculator – Basic – not scientific
- 1 Pencil case

Optional: Coloured gel pens and/or felt pens. These will be used for charts and worksheets, not in books.

Please ensure **ALL** items (even the eraser and ruler) are **clearly named**. Pencil cases make desk organisation a lot easier. We encourage children to have their books covered as it helps create a sense of pride in their work presentation.
