We ask that you purchase the following stationery for your child during the holidays so that every child will have their stationery available on the first day of term, 2nd February, 2010.

May we suggest you look carefully at **quality** as well as price, particularly good quality pencils. We will keep a small stock of stationery at school for children to purchase during the year as their exercise books run out.

- 6 Pencils named
- 1 30cm ruler – Not FLEXI
- 1 Eraser
- 1 Pencil sharpener
- 2 Red biro
- 2 Blue biro
- 1 Packet 12 full-size coloured pencils (Good quality)
- 1 Large glue stick
- 1 Protractor
- 1 Lined refill (no holes)
- 1 20 page Clearfile (Old one can be re-used)
- 2 Good quality scrapbooks (not newsprint) for Topic
- 6 115 Exercise books (Draft writing, Handwriting, Homework, Spelling, Reading & English)
- 1 1E5 Maths book
- 1 SA4 Science Book (One page line, one page blank) – for RE
- 1 Art envelope – A3 size (manilla) – Only if your child needs a new one.
- 1 Journal bag – Large – for library books and notices
- 1 Calculator – Basic not scientific
- 2 Small boxes of tissues – One to be kept by the teacher and one to be kept in their desk.

Optional: Coloured gel pens and/or felt pens. These will be used for charts and worksheets, not in books.

Please ensure **ALL** items (even the eraser and ruler) are **clearly named**. Pencil cases make desk organisation a lot easier. We encourage children to have their books covered as it helps create a sense of pride in their work presentation.
