Confirmation is the sacrament that completes the grace we receive in Baptism. It seals, or confirms, this grace through the seven Gifts of the Holy Spirit that we receive as part of Confirmation.

This Saturday evening Cardinal John Dew will administer the Sacrament of Confirmation on 29 young people in our parish. Please keep them in your prayers.
