

Following the viewing of the Caritas 2015 DVD and a presentation from Cathy Bi who will talk to the stories in the DVD, Kilian de Lacy will share her experiences working with GreyPower.

At a General Audience address in May 2013, Pope Francis made this statement: "What is God's plan? It is to make of us all a single family of His children, in which each person feels that God is close and feels loved by Him." Did You Know? 47% transient students in Decile 1 schools moved because of housing issues compared to only 9% in Decile 10 schools. (NZ Federation of Principals 2001.)
