During the holidays the staff attended a range of professional development that supports our school-wide focus on Growth Mindsets and we are all excited to start putting some of our new learning into action. We also attended KiVa training and are now officially a KiVa school. This programme is essentially education on what bullying is and how we can prevent it. The programme has training for staff, children and parents and is backed up with an online resource that can be accessed both at home and school. Although we don't see bullying as a problem at St. Theresa's, there is clear evidence through surveying our community that we do not have a shared definition of bullying and that our children need support in identifying bullying behaviours. We feel the KiVa programme will support us to be proactive rather than reactive. Please join us on Thursday, 23rd February when we will be presenting the programme to the community and answering any questions you may have.
